TO THE COURT:

NOW COMES Harriet Nicholson and files this her timely "Motion to Recuse Judge Ray Wheless and Kristina Williams" and would show unto the Court the following:

Plaintiff's motion is timely because Ms. Nicholson began to notice the unfairness, bias, prejudice and partiality of the Court as stated infra on November 29, 2021. When a recusal motion is timely filed, Rule 18a leaves a trial judge with no discretion—the trial judge must either recuse himself or refer the motion for another judge to decide. See Rule 18a(c). A timely filed recusal motion triggers the trial judge's duty to recuse or to refer. The trial judge has no such duty when a recusal motion is not timely filed. See Arnold, 853 S.W.2d at 544-45.

Plaintiff's Request to Recuse Senior Judge Wheless from any further proceedings in the pending case pursuant to Texas Rules of Procedure 1, 18(a) and 18(b)

On November 22, 2021, Judge Wheless heard Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment via zoom and rendered judgment, "Denying Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment." in open court. "Judgment is rendered when the trial court officially announces its decision in open court or by written memorandum filed with the clerk." *S & A Rest. Corp. v. Leal*, 892 S.W.2d 855, 857 (Tex. 1995). ¹

On November 23, 2021, Plaintiff filed her "Motion for Sanctions."²

On November 24, 2021, Plaintiff filed a "Letter to the Court" asking the Court to enter judgment. "Entry of judgment is a purely ministerial act by which the trial court's judgment is made of record and preserved." *Skidmore*, 781 S.W.2d at 673. ³

On November 29, 2021, Plaintiff filed a "Motion to Rule" asking for entry of judgment rendered on November 22, 2021.⁴

On November 22, 2021, Judge Wheless heard six motions in the 192nd District Court; signing three orders, including orders in case DC-21-14655 and
