**ORDER**


On June 5, 2018, this Court ordered Plaintiff to file an amended petition within twenty-one days that is compliant with the issues raised in the Court's June 5 Order. The order cautioned Plaintiff that "[f]ailure to file an amended petition within twenty-one days shall result in the dismissal of Plaintiffs' case."<sup>1</sup> More than twenty-one days have passed, and Plaintiff has failed to file an amended petition. Thus, Plaintiff has failed to comply with the Court's June 5 order, and this case is therefore dismissed for want of prosecution. FED.R.Civ.P.41(b). Accordingly, the Court hereby

**ORDERS** that Plaintiffs' case is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
