**DOCKET CONTROL ORDER**

The Court enters the following Order to control the schedule of this case. Unless otherwise specified, the following items must be completed by the dates listed below. If no date is listed, them item is governed by the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure.

**Expert witness designation:** Parties must designate expert witnesses and furnish the information as follows per Rule 195.2 Texas Rules of Civil Procedure:

Experts for parties for parties seeking affirmative relief: 90 days before the end of the discovery period (See below).

All other experts: 60 days before the end of the discovery period (See below)

**Discovery:** September 23, 2022. Parties must complete discovery. Parties seeking discovery must serve requests sufficiently far in advance of the end of the discovery period so that the deadline for responding will be within the discovery period.

**Dispositive Motions:** Parties must set for hearing VIA ZOOM all motions or pleas, that if granted by the Court would dispose of all or part of the case as follows per Rule 166a of the Texas Civil Procedure:

No evidence motions for summary judgment: September 30, 2022

All dispositive or pleas must be heard: October 14, 2022


**Challenges to Expert Testimony.** All motions to exclude expert testimony must be heard VIA ZOOM October 14, 2022. This order does not include exclusion based on Rule 193.6.

**Final Conference (via Zoom):** November 7, 2022. Parties must be prepared to discuss all aspects of trial.

**Trial (in person):** November 15, 2022.
