ORDER EXTENDING TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND ORDER RE-SETTING HEARING ON APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY INJUNCTIONTRO

4. The Parties may agree to modify these deadlines, in accordance with the law, without further order from this Court.
