- (c) Plaintiffs are awarded fee simple title to the Property located at 4326 Whippoorwill Circle, Missouri City, Fort Bend County, Texas 77459 and more particularly described as: Lot Seven (7) in Block Two (2) Oyster Creek Plantation, Section Two, an Addition in Fort Bend County, Texas, According to the map or plat thereof, Recorded in Slide Nos. 1665/A and 1665/B of the Plat Records of Fort Bend County, Texas;
 - (d) Defendant is ordered to pay all taxable costs of court;
- (e) Plaintiffs are hereby awarded all writs and processes for enforcement of collection of this judgment as are necessary; and
- (f) This judgment shall be recorded in the real property records of Fort Benel County Texas.


