



1. Defendant American Lapping Technology, LLC was not found at its registered office, and was therefore served both by private process to the registered agent's wife at the registered agent's residence on October 15, 2019, and through the Texas Secretary of State, in compliance with 12 O.S. §2004(C)(4) and Section 5.251 of the Texas Business Organizations Code on February 19, 2020.

2. Defendant Lennart Chip Morander was served with the Summons and Petition herein through his wife at his residence by private process on October 15, 2019.

3. By said process, as modified in the Oklahoma Supreme Court's Third Emergency Joint Order Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster (SCAD 2020-36), an answer or appearance by each Defendant was due in this case no later than June 1, 2020.

4. Defendants have wholly neglected, failed and refused to file a written answer or pleading to the Plaintiff's Petition herein, and are therefore in default.


5. Plaintiff is entitled to judgment on the merits of this cause by virtue of Defendants' default.
