DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OF THE COURT'S JANUARY 29, 2024 ORDER STRICKING DEDENDANT'S DEMAND FOR A JURY TRIAL

Defendant Elliotte P. Coleman ("Coleman"), proceeding *pro se*, hereby moves the Court to reconsider its January 29, 2024 Order stricking his demand for a jury trial. On January 11, 2024 Plaintiff Carrington Mortgage Services, LLP. ("Carrington") filed a motion moving the Court to comply with an earlier Order stricking Coleman's jury demand. For reasons beyond his control Coleman didn't file a timely opposition and by Order dated January 29, 2024 the Court granted Carrington's motion. As expressed more fully in the following, the relief Coleman seeks herein is just and proper.

Background

On November 2, 2023 the District of Columbia Metropolitan Police Department ("MPD") and the Prince George's County Police Department ('PGD") arrested Coleman for a crime that he didn't commit. See **Exhibit A**, Clothing, Personal Property and Cash Record. He was transferred to a detention facility in Prince George's County, Maryland on November 8,

2023. See Exhibit B, Intake Property Form. He was released on February 14, 2024. See Exhibit C, Notice of Acquittal.¹

While incarcerated Coleman had no access to the Court's docket sheet and received no mailings or verbal communications from the Court.²

On January 29, 2024 the Court granted Carrington's motion to strick Coleman's demand for a jury trial while he was incarcerated.

This case has proceeded for over 10 years and the related papers that Coleman has is volumous and most are unbound. On November 2, 2023 law enforcement ram shacked his home while he was incarcerated. They strewed paper throughout the entire house and Coleman is still struggling to reorganize the paper.

Argument

The Court's January 29, 2024 Order stricking Coleman's demand for a jury trial is confusing. Specifically, it relies upon an Order filed by the Court on June 5, 2017. However, the Court's June 5, 2017 Order is void of any reference to Coleman's request for a jury trial.

Coleman sought Plaintiff's consent to this motion. He didn't receive consent.


