Appellants filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file appellants' brief. Although the clerk's record was filed on April 14, 2025, the time for filing appellants' brief has not begun to run because the reporter's record has not been filed. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 38.6(a) (appellants' brief due 30 days after later of filing of clerk's record or filing of reporter's record). Accordingly, the motion for an extension of time is denied as moot.

We further note that the court reporter filed an information sheet on February 19, 2025, stating that appellants have not paid for or requested preparation of the reporter's record. The Clerk of this Court notified appellants that unless they provided proof by May 9, 2025 that they paid or made arrangements to pay for the reporter's record, the Court might consider the appeal without a reporter's record. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(c). Appellants did not respond.

Accordingly, the Court will consider and decide those issues or points that do not require a reporter's record for a decision. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(c). Appellants' brief is ORDERED to be filed within **60 days of the date of this order**.

It is so ORDERED.
